RESOLUTION No. 011.2023

RE: Medicotek, Inc.

as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for the Project,

re: 1 pc. Dual Energy Multi-Slice CT Scan Machine with capabilities for cardiovascular, brain, Head and Neck and Body imaging including all peripherals necessary for these examination and for the safety of patients and those who will perform the imaging studies as well as the necessary capabilities for storage and transmittal of imaging data to the existing PACS of the PHC - ITB.089.22

WHEREAS, the Philippine Heart Center (PHC) in consonance to the requirements of RA 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRRs), has advertised the Invitation to Bid for the Project, re: **1 pc. Dual Energy Multi-Slice CT Scan Machine with capabilities for cardiovascular, brain, Head and Neck and Body imaging including all peripherals necessary for these examination and for the safety of patients and those who will perform the imaging studies as well as the necessary capabilities for storage and transmittal of imaging data to the existing PACS of the PHC** at the Bulletin Board of the PHC-BAC Secretariat and posted the same in PHILGEPS and in other conspicuous of the premises of this institution continuously for a period fourteen (14) days;

WHEREAS, in response to the said PHC's widely-disseminated advertisements, four (4) prospective bidders participated in the bidding process by purchasing the BAC-prepared bid documents for the Project;

WHEREAS, the bid documents of the bidders were subjected to a "pass or fail" criteria during the Bid Opening Date based on the PHC's itemized checklist in the bidding documents;

However, during the Bid Opening Date on November 03, 2022, Medicotek, Inc., was found to be ineligible to bid due to the following deficiencies as follows:

- 1.9 Networking Connectivity and Archiving
 - 1.9.1 DICOM Storage (Send and Receive)
 - 1.9.2 DICOM Query and Retrieve
 - 1.9.3 DICOM Print and Filming
 - 1.9.5 DICOM MMPS
 - 1.9.11 Image Transfer

Immediately, Medicotek, Inc., authorized representative requested that they will file Motion for Reconsideration.

On November 07, 2022, the BAC Secretariat received the MR of Medicotek, Inc.

BAC on the other hand, reviewed and ascertained the MR of Medicotek, Inc., and on November 15, 2022, as per BAC.Ref.399.22, the MR of Medicotek was granted and found to be complete in form and in substance.

WHEREAS, the result of the evaluation shows the following notation:

WHEREAS, a post-qualification process was scheduled in favor of Medicotek, Inc., being the 2nd Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) on December 15, 2022.

WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation and verification of the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted by **Medicotek, Inc.**, the bidder with the 2nd Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB), we find the above-mentioned bid offers, to be **Non-Responsive** to the stipulated requirements of the Project; to wit:

5.5.1 All Parts and Services

5.5.2 Preventive Maintenance of 5 years supposedly but Medicotek, Inc., supported by a certification of 3 years instead of 5 years.

As per BAC.Ref.065.23 dated February 21, 2023, the decision of the BAC consensus is final, that Medicotek, Inc. is post-disqualified.

Medicotek, Inc., filed **Protest** on March 01, 2023, paid the Protest Fee in the amount of P650,000.00 (5% of the ABC – P130M). Also, a verified position paper was received by the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) - Dr. Joel M. Abanilla.

On March 08, 2023, the HOPE GRANTED and ACCEPTED the protest filed by Medicotek, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, we, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED:

- a). To recommend to the Executive Director, being the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE), the approval of this Resolution and award of the Project to **Medicotek, Inc.**






