Still monitoring our **COVID 19 data, for February 11, 2021 census** shows that we have a total of thirty five **(35) patients**. Twenty four (24) confirmed, two (2) suspect and nine (9) probable COVID cases. Currently, twenty (20) PHC Staff are admitted.

To date there are five hundred twelve **(512) recovered COVID patients** while seventy five (75) patients expired and a total of five hundred eighty seven **(587) patients were discharged**.
