Now in the last quarter of 2020 when all sectors have practically administered all measures to boost the economy in adherence to the IATF guidelines in the time of the COVID-19 pandemic, the country faced five tropical typhoons all within the past three-week period. The latest typhoon, Ulysses, was recorded as the strongest typhoon of 2020. Surpassing the level of 2009's Typhoon Ondoy, Typhoon Ulysses has brought extensive flooding in parts of Metro Manila and other regions in Luzon.

The government's rescue and relief operations are now in place. Likewise, we at Philippine Heart Center will not turn a blind eye on our grief-stricken *kababayans* as we reach out to them. Embracing our culture of charity and generosity, we will have a relief drive not only for our employees but also for communities hardest hit by the typhoon like Montalban (Rodriguez), San Mateo, and Marikina.

We are calling all kind hearts, please share your blessings either in cash or in kind like beddings/linens, hygiene kits, canned goods, noodles, clothing, bottled water, and biscuits, or any non-perishable item.

For cash donations, payment shall be accepted by the Treasury Division c/o Mr. Albert Jimenez II while donation of any kind shall be accepted by Mr. Alvin De Leon of the Property and Supply Management Division and Engr. Dionisio Eoy, Jr. of the Engineering and Maintenance Division.

Donation drop boxes are stationed at the following areas:

1. Ground Floor – Beside the Medical Triage Area, MAB Lobby

2. Second Floor- In front of the Education, Training and Research Services Office, MAB
3. Third Floor- Beside the Renal Section Office and the Foyer of the CHF Grand Auditorium, MAB Annex.

The COVID census continues its decline. For November 16, 2020, we have a **total COVID Care Census** of twenty-three (23) **patients** with twenty-one (21) **confirmed**, two (2) **suspect**, and no **probable** COVID cases. Currently, no PHC Staff is admitted.

To date, there are four hundred six (406) recovered COVID patients while sixty (60) patients expired, and a total of four hundred sixty-six (466) patients were discharged.
